

CODE OF CONDUCT & BEHAVIOUR POLICY

1. GALAXY HOUSE RULES

- a. **Listen to the Coach** Our coaches are responsible for your learning and safety. We emphasize building a **strong foundation** before progressing to more advanced skills.
- b. Respect and Inclusivity We foster an inclusive and non-judgmental community. Bullying, discrimination, racism, bias, or harassment of any kind will not be tolerated. Support, motivate, and encourage one another—everyone learns at their own pace.
- c. **Safety First** Never attempt skills that you are **not physically or mentally ready** for. Always check for **safety and supervision** before performing any movement.
- d. No Food or Drinks in the Gym Space To maintain cleanliness and safety, food and drinks are not allowed in the gymnastics area. Water stations are available—please bring your own refillable bottle.
- e. **Effort Over Perfection** Always try your best. Aim to improve your skills and **compete with** your own progress, not others.
- f. **Respect the Equipment** Equipment should be treated with care. **Misusing or failing to return equipment** reflects negatively on discipline and sportsmanship.

2. CLASS ETIQUETTE & RULES

- a. **Punctuality Matters** Arrive at least 5 minutes early and leave promptly after class.
- b. Late Arrival Policy Students arriving more than 15 minutes late will not be allowed entry for safety reasons.
- c. Readiness for Group Classes Participants aged 3 and above must be potty-trained and able to function in a group setting without one-on-one supervision.

d. Trial and Enrollment Readiness

- a. All students must complete a trial class before enrolling in a regular class package.
- Galaxy Gymnastics reserves the right to assess whether a student is ready for group classes. If a student is deemed not ready or unable to follow instructions, we may suggest alternative programs.



c. No refunds will be provided if a student does not qualify for regular classes after the trial.

3. BEHAVIOUR EXPECTATIONS & DISCIPLINARY ACTIONS

- a. **Respect Others** Students must treat coaches, staff, and peers with kindness and respect. **Bullying, teasing, or disruptive behaviour will not be tolerated.**
- b. Handling Special Needs & Behavioural Considerations
 - a. Galaxy Gymnastics welcomes children with special needs (e.g., Autism, ADHD, etc.), but they must be able to follow class instructions and safety rules.
 - b. Our coaches are not specialized therapists. If a student requires one-on-one support beyond our capabilities, we may recommend alternative arrangements.
- c. If a child's behaviour **becomes disruptive or poses a safety concern**, Galaxy Gymnastics reserves the right to:
 - i. Recommend a different class format (e.g., private lessons).
 - ii. Decline enrollment in group classes.
 - iii. No refunds will be provided if a student is removed due to behavioral concerns.
- d. **Addressing Disruptive Behaviour** If a participant continuously **disrupts the class**, the following steps will be taken:
 - i. **Verbal warning** from the coach.
 - ii. **Temporary removal** from an activity to allow the student to reset behaviour.
 - iii. **Discussion with parents** to find a resolution.
 - iv. **Final removal from the program** if behaviour persists.
- e. **Right to Refuse Service** Galaxy Gymnastics reserves the right to **refuse service** to anyone demonstrating **violent, threatening, inappropriate, rude, or unruly behaviour** toward staff or students. No refunds will be issued in such cases.

4. EXCLUSION FROM ACTIVITIES & REFUND POLICY

- a. Removal Due to Behaviour or Safety Concerns If a participant's behaviour is deemed unsafe or disruptive, Galaxy Gymnastics reserves the right to remove them from classes or camps.
- b. No Refunds for Dismissed Participants No refunds will be provided for any remaining sessions if a participant is removed due to behavioural concerns.
- c. **Costs Associated with Exclusion** Any associated **costs (including transport home)** will be the responsibility of the participant, parent, or guardian.



5. NON-PARTICIPANTS ETIQUETTE (PARENTS, GURDIANS & VISITORS)

- a. **Respect the Gym Space** Parents, siblings, and other non-participating individuals must remain **outside** the gymnastics area.
- b. No External Coaching Parents and visitors must not shout instructions or attempt to coach students during class. Allow students to focus on their learning in a supportive and non-judgmental environment.
- c. **Strict Enforcement of Safety Protocols** Non-participants **will be escorted out** if they do not comply with gym rules as safety is our top priority.
- d. Seating Policy Non-participants are not allowed to occupy space within the gymnastics area during class.
- e. **Encouragement for Parents** We encourage parents/guardians to take a break, enjoy shopping, or grab a dessert while waiting for the class to finish. The mall offers great options for this!
- f. **Capture and Share Moments** Parents are welcome to record their gymnast's achievements during class. If posting on social media, **please hashtag us**: #galaxygymnastics #galaxygymnasticssg #Agymoutofthisworld
- g. **Be on Time for Drop-off and Pick-up** Late pick-ups may cause class disruptions and **additional fees may apply** if this condition is not reasonably met.

6. RIGHT TO REFUSE SERVICE

a. Galaxy Gymnastics reserves the right to refuse service to any individual displaying violent, threatening, inappropriate, rude, or disruptive behaviour toward any member of our team.

7. PRIVACY POLICY

- a. **Use of Personal Information** Any information collected will only be used for session confirmations, class updates, and Galaxy Gymnastics announcements.
- b. **Respect for Your Data** We appreciate your trust in providing contact details and ensure all information is handled with care.
